### **REGISTERING WITH THE ACADEMY**

To allow players to train with, and play for, the Widnes Wild Academy, players must register with the English Ice Hockey association via the club. To allow us to register your player as a club member and as a player, we need the following:

# Players Born in the UK

- 1. Completed the Online EIHA Registration Forms.
- 2. Read all policies within this Welcome pack and complete and sign the Club Registration Document.

# Players Born outside of the UK (Including British players born abroad)

- 1. All documents required for UK born players (Listed above)
- 2. International Transfer Form.
- 3. Unlimited Transfer request (If requesting an unlimited transfer).
- 4. Parental Letter (Players moving from Canada only)
- 5. Registration fee and transfer fee payment \*.

\*Players requiring international transfer must also pay a transfer fee of £72, this is paid to IHUK via the club. Please see one of our registration secretaries for more information on international transfers.

# **PAYMENTS**

Fees for registration as required by EIHA for the current season.

These fees are paid when joining the club and then annually, each July, for the following season.

# **Monthly Training Subs - Paid by Standing Order**

A direct debit payment plan needs to be set up through online/telephone banking or by request we can provide a standing order mandate to be given to your bank if needed.

Subs are payable on  $1^{st}$  of each month. This is £70 per month for one player, or £65 per player, per month if you have two or more siblings at the club.

Any training prior to the 1st of the month can be paid weekly to a club official at a rate of £13 per child per session or a one-off bank payment for the full month's subs can be made by BACS.

# **CLUB FUNDRAISING**

Fundraising is a key part to the running of the club, this allows us to register coaches, managers and officials; put people through the correct courses, pay for on ice and off-ice equipment, pay for referee's fee's on game days, pay for items which benefit and help the club run and much more.

We have our own Last one standing competition; we run match night 50-50's and raffles, match night programmes, used kit sale's, our very own Wild Academy Merchandise store, along with much more to aid

# For players born in the UK:

- Completed Club Registration Form
- Completion of the EIHA Online Registration
- o Payment sent to the EIHA through their Online Registration Process
- Standing order set up for subs on 1<sup>st</sup> of the month.
- Jersey Order Form and paid

# For non-British and players born abroad:

- o All documents listed for UK born players
- Copies of all held passports.
- o International Transfer (Request Application form from a committee member).
- Unlimited Transfer Request (If an unlimited transfer is required).
- Parental Letter A letter confirming the player has re-located to the UK with the family (This letter is only required for players who are Canadian or players who have been playing in Canada).
